Conversions

The metric system is based on units of 10. Here are some simple conversions you may want to use:

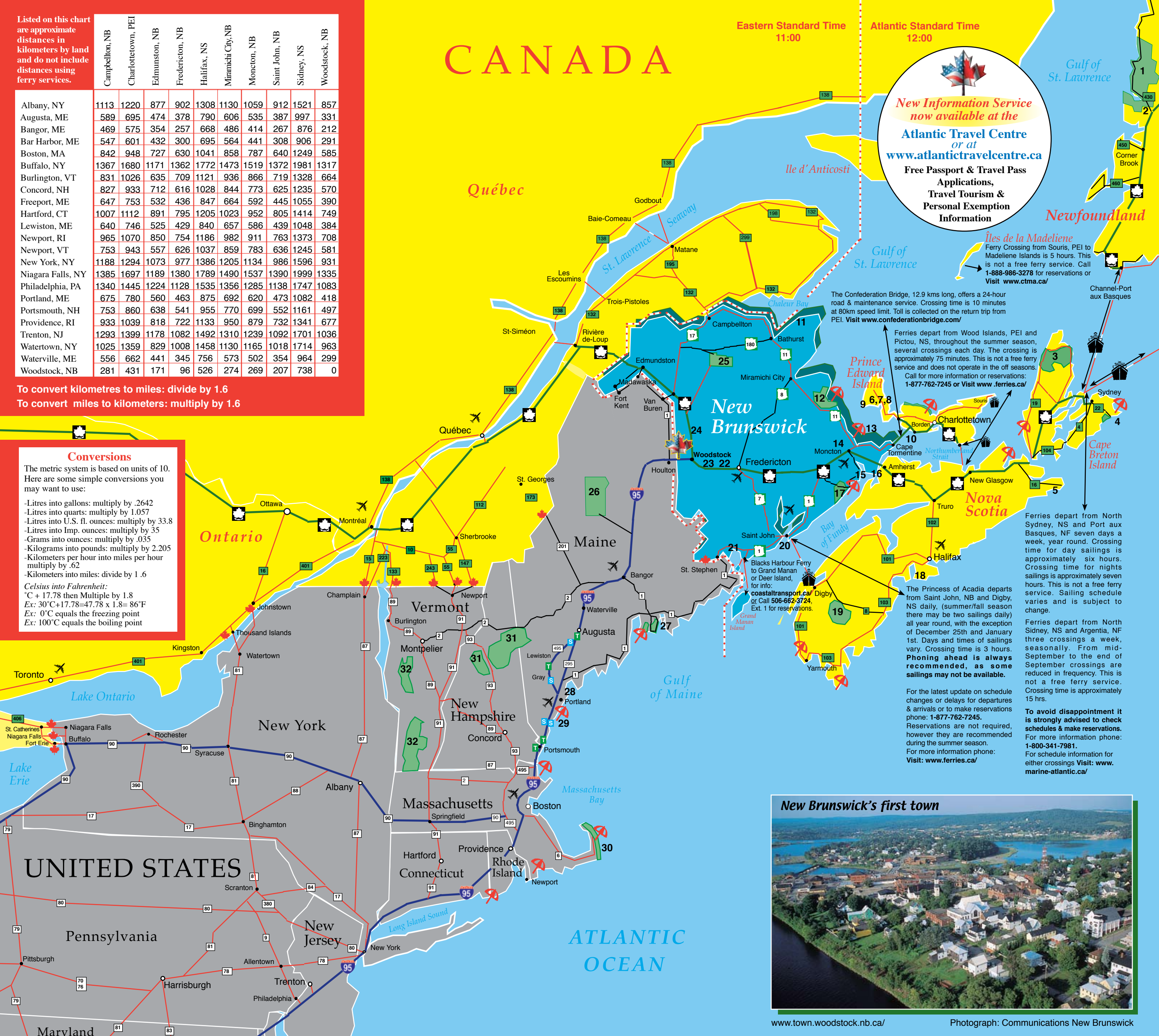
- Litres into gallons: multiply by .2642
- Litres into quarts: multiply by 1.057
- Litres into U.S. fl. ounces: multiply by 33.8
- Litres into Imp. ounces: multiply by 35
- Grams into ounces: multiply by .035
- Kilograms into pounds: multiply by 2.205
- Kilometers per hour into miles per hour multiply by .62
- Kilometers into miles: divide by 1.6

Celsius into Fahrenheit:
°C + 17.78 then Multiply by 1.8
Ex: 30°C + 17.78 = 47.78 x 1.8 = 86°F
Ex: 0°C equals the freezing point
Ex: 100°C equals the boiling point

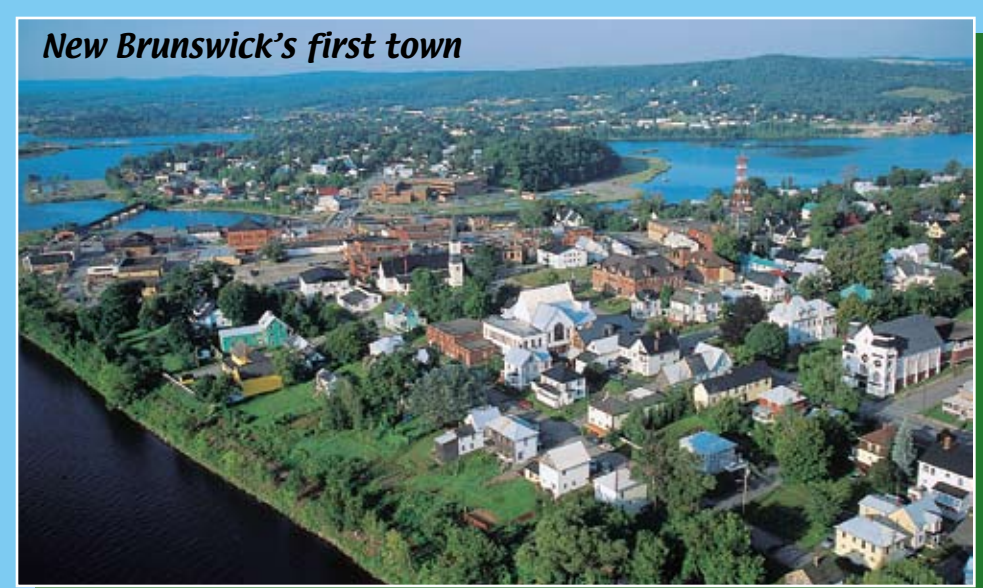
Ferries depart from Wood Islands, PEI and Pictou, NS, throughout the summer season, several crossings each day. The crossing is approximately 75 minutes. This is not a free ferry service and does not operate in the off seasons. Call for more information or reservations: 1-877-762-7245 or Visit www.ferries.ca/

Ferries depart from North Sydney, NS and Port aux Basques, NF seven days a week, year round. Crossing time for day sailings is approximately six hours. Crossing time for nights sailings is approximately seven hours. This is not a free ferry service. Sailing schedule varies and is subject to change.

Ferries depart from North Sydney, NS and Argentea, NF three crossings a week, seasonally. From mid-September to the end of September crossings are reduced in frequency. This is not a free ferry service. Crossing time is approximately 15 hrs.
